Features of a Diary Entry Uses the past tense Uses first person pronouns (I, we, my, etc) Describes the writer's point of view, thoughts and feelings Includes opinions as well as facts Uses ambitious words to describe people and places Is written in an informal style, as though speaking to someone Uses time conjunctions to link events

Features of a diary entry: Diary writing is a piece of text that is logged by date and/or time Typically diary writing is used to recall the events of the day or week, and the feelings, thoughts and opinions that go with it The dates break up your diary into smaller pieces, almost like chapters of a book!
