Instructional Strategies - Education

Instructional strategies are techniques teachers use to help students become independent, strategic learners These strategies become learning strategies when students independently select the appropriate ones and use them effectively to accomplish tasks or meet goals Instructional strategies can: • motivate students and help them focus

become strategic readers Strategic reading, according to Alfassi (2010) requires that learners intentionally engage in planned actions under their control, in the manner that proficient readers do when they encounter difficulty in comprehending a text Alfassi further points out that those

teachers to motivate students' participation in their learning and teach them how to read effectively In a large number of research studies conducted in the past three decades, comprehension strategy instruction including multiple reading strategies has been justified to be beneficial to helping students become strategic

4. LEARNING STRATEGIES, SUPPORTS, AND INTERVENTIONS

Students who are alcohol-affected may become frustrated when presented with a large assignment or research project It is possible to avoid this frustration by using scaffolding - a strategy of providing clear structure and precisely stated expectations, and breaking

activity No matter their age, students recognize the need to communicate in writing As teachers, we are faced with the task of helping students view writing as essential to learning In addition to promoting the need for good communication skills, teaching writing provides opportunities for students to develop clear thinking skills When

Framing Main Ideas and Essential Details

When students learn to organize information using graphic organizers, they are also basic information processing skills as well as analytical thinking skills In short, graphic organizers can help students with LD become strategic learners when use of graphic organizers becomes second nature to them

Helping Students Become Self-Regulated Learners • What is Self-Regulated Learning? • Thoughts, feelings, or actions purposely generated and controlled by student to maximize learning of knowledge and skills for a given task and set of conditions • Self-regulated learners also referred to as self-directed, autonomous, or strategic learners
