EXPLORING RECOUNTS—A SAMPLE UNIT The following unit is an example of one approach to teaching about recounts using an example of an historical recount It is assumed that teachers would contextualise the study of recounts, select mentor recounts to suit their teaching purposes and adjust the teaching focuses according to the students' needs

Unit 1 Recount - The Grid

In pairs children use the 'I can' statements from lesson 1 to evaluate their own written recounts Children set two targets for improvement Lesson objectives: to write a recount of a historical event with a known ending; to engage the reader's interest in the recount by describing events using details that bring incidents alive

Progression in recount - Primary English

Watch or listen to third person recounts such as news or sports reports on television, radio or podcast Identify the sequence of main events Read examples of third person recounts such as letters, newspaper reports and diaries and recount the same event ...

Introduction

historical recount, science experiment, traffic report, sport report or in film, television and video At this stage recounts involve detailed research about unfamiliar topics for which students should be using print and technological resources Appropriate technical language, precise details of time, place and manner and retelling with appropriate
