Psychotropic Medications and Adverse Side Effects

psychotropic medications • More medication use in older adults • Many adults experience long-term use of medications that affect the central nervous system (ie anti-seizure meds) • Medication use may result in undesired or adverse side effects • Taking multiple medications increases the likelihood of having at least one side effect

Psychiatric medications: Adverse cutaneous drug reactions

Exanthematous reactions Exanthematous reactions are the most common ACDR with psychotropic medications Although they can occur with any of the antidepressants, mood stabilizers, or antipsychotics,¹⁷ they are more likely to be an initial symptom of a more severe or life-threatening reaction with the mood stabilizers

contributing to tardive dyskinesia This medication often used to treat psychosis after three failed attempts with other antipsychotics to control symptoms Most feared side-effect related to agranulocytosis (decreased white blood cells) Initially needs weekly monitoring for blood cell counts than every two weeks Also carries a risk for

Medication Administration Module

are chemical compounds that modify human body processes They may alter chemical reactions, fight, cure, or prevent disease, relieve disease symptoms, maintain health, aid in diagnosis, or alter a normal process For example, psychotropic medications change behavior through altering, blocking, destroying, or augmenting brain chemicals

Adverse Events: Most common adverse reactions in clinical trials in children and adolescents (incidence $\geq 5\%$ and twice placebo): somnolence, extrapyramidal

The administration of psychotropic medication should involve appropriate education of the patient and caretaker, an adequate trial, and careful monitoring by the prescribing practitioner along with other treatment providers
