The body of your Teddy Bear is done! Finish face details: • Attach eyes • Cut a nose out of felt, put in place and hand sew all around • Fold mouth as shown, pin and tack into place • Hand sew head to body with an invisible seam

Designs used in this tutorial include M3958, Teddy Bear Face 1 - Smiling Find even more Teddy Bear face designs here Special Notes: When choosing faux fur fabric, pick a fabric with shorter fur The fur used in this tutorial is about 1/2" in length Longer furs might cause the embroidery to sink too far into the fabric Finished Sizes:

ASSEMBLING YOUR BEAR Cut outside of pattern Always match seams before dots ¼" seam allowances throughout Please study the bear photograph later in these directions to see how everything comes together Finished bear = approximately 17 inches long Please do not add a face to you bear - no noses, no eyes, no buttons, etc

For front bib decoration the teddy bear may be cut from a juvenile print fabric or a purchased applique If using juvenile print fabric iron Wonder Under® on the back of the bear material Cut out bear, peel off the paper backing and iron bear on the bib front according to the instructions with the Wonder Under® DIAGRAM A wrong side of suit

Finished Toy Size: TEDDY 33cm/13inches

Turn your Teddy right sides out through the gap left on one side If you are using craft eyes, insert them now before you stuff your teddy If you are using buttons or beads for eyes, you will sew them on when Teddy's head is stuffed! (Do not use beads, buttons or craft eyes for children under 3 years old, it is safer to embroider the eyes)

Baby Pip Teddy Bear - Sewing Machines Plus

Baby Pip Teddy Bear Pattern 1 Baby Pip Teddy Bear Pattern 2 Paste the pattern pieces onto cardboard and cut out to make templates for your pieces Lay your templates on the wrong side of the fabric, matching the arrows to the pile of your fur (PILE is the direction in which the fur lies)

Knitting a Trauma Teddy - Australian Red Cross

1/8 yard (15 cm) teddy bear solid (C100-22 Teddy Bear) 1/8 yard (15 cm) scrubs solid (C100-49 Scrubs) Teddy Bear Solid Cut 10 small eyes (5 left and 5 right) and 5 beaks using the templates provided Reverse templates or add Hoos Hanging Out ©2015 Riley Blake Designs Sugar Pink Solid Cut 6 wings (3 left and 3 right) using the templates

Repeat for the bear's second ear Using the patterns, cut from the knit fabric: 2 Bear Heads 2 Ears 2 Body pieces 2 Arms 2 reversed Arms 2 Legs 2 reversed Legs 1 Tail Using the pattern, cut from the printed cotton: 2 Ears Using the pattern, cut from the felt: 1 Vest Using the patterns, trace the appliqués onto the fusible webbing with a pencil,

November Bulletin Boards

Cut out the children's faces, and attach the photos to the tops of teddy bear cutouts (Teddy bear patterns are available as on Online Resource at funshineexpress.com) Attach the bears to the bulletin board, along with star and moon cutouts Add the title,
