#### **Egyptian Paste - Ceramic Arts Network**

Jewelry or small sculptures made this way may be very beautiful in surface and color Beads may be fired strung on Kanthal or kiln element wire in the kiln, which will prevent the slight scar that occurs if the bead is placed on a kiln shelf (Such scars can be minimized if the shelf is dusted lightly with alumina hydrate or calcium carbonate)
