PHARMACEUTICAL MANAGEMENT and FORMULARY MANUAL

Pharmacy: Locations licensed by the state of Washington State Pharmacy Quality Assurance Commission where the practice of pharmacy is allowed as defined in statute Practitioner (Prescriber): A person duly authorized by law or rule in the state of Washington (or another state, when patients are cared for in that state) to prescribe drugs
