Having a wider pelvis at the top (meaning your hip bones stick out a little more), or a pelvis that sits quite high, is one cause of a 'H-shaped' butt in women. Males have a taller and narrower pelvis – leading to a squarer butt shape: Buttocks Muscles. Muscles, along with fat, make up the main bulk and shape of the buttocks.
