1. Beauty. The study of Plato on beauty must begin with one warning. The Greek adjective kalon only approximates to the English “ beautiful. ” Not everything Plato says about a kalos, kal ê , or kalon thing will belong in a summary of his aesthetic theories. Readers can take this distinction between the Greek and English terms too far.
