Marshall was a gypsy descendant of Roma people and a bare knuckled boxer before classic boxing rules were laid out in the mid 1700's. Head butting, eye gouging, chin kicks, and wrestling were all permitted and each of three bouts saw various weapons being used including swords, knives and cudgels or quarterstaves (long sticks).
